Stratamed is semi-occlusive and hydrophobic and does not adhere strongly to the newly formed granulating tissue¹, which leads to

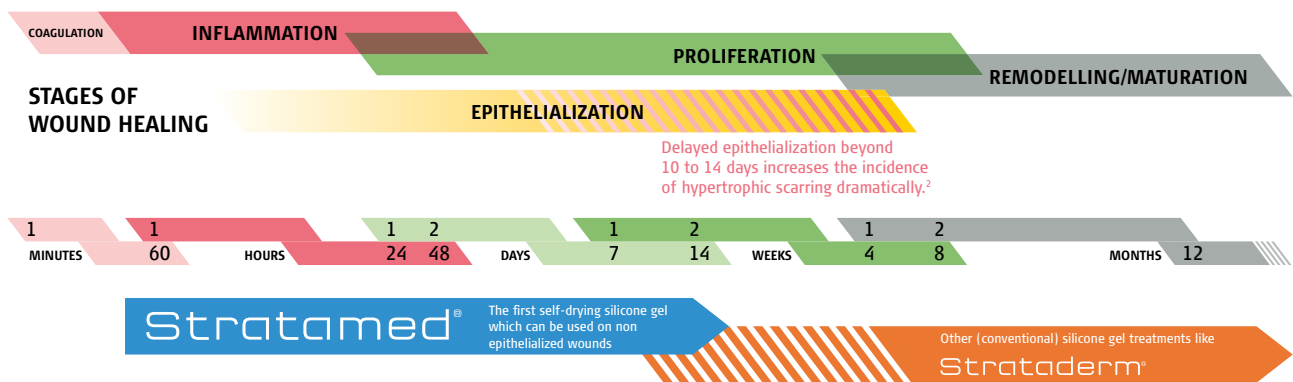
- Improved tissue hydration

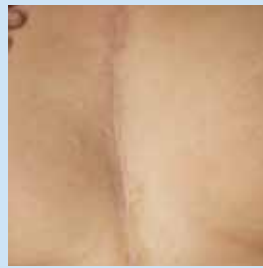

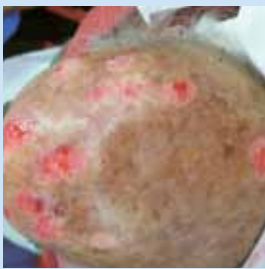

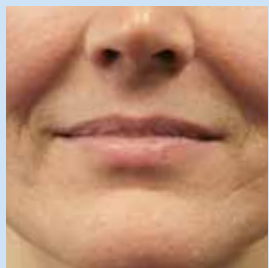
